- Implement emergency procedures relevant to the significant incident.
- Ensure adequate first aid provision and report incidents as required under HSE requirements and legal obligations.
- Provide sufficient information, training and instruction to ensure employees are competent to carry out their work.
- Ensure suitable supervision in relation to risk and complexity of tasks.
- To properly consult and communicate health and safety matters at all levels of the business.
- Work closely with contractors, suppliers and other stakeholders to ensure adequate levels of health and safety performance are maintained and achieved.
